Our work:

Co-operatives Yorkshire and the Humber have developed a network of over 200 co-operatives and organised a number of high profile events including Futures North and the Co-operative Councils Conference and Network. Over the last few years SEYH have organised a social enterprise network across the whole of the region, seeing over 500 different organisations take part in the network. SEYH members have had the opportunity to attend and network with private sector companies, key staff at public authorities, funders, and many other social enterprises.

Both organisations host a regularly updated website- including news stories, job vacancies, directory, and a calendar of events. Traffic is constantly driven to our site, and our content publicised externally, through our social media accounts. Each month hundreds of organisations and individuals from all sectors receive our e-newsletter, featuring the latest news, information, opportunities, and events for the sector.

Both organisations been heavily engaged in policy and lobbying work over the last year given the political developments impacting upon the sector. Members have been consulted on the Local Enterprise Partnerships, Regional Growth Fund, and a host of other consultations. Based on our members' views, we lobbied every single local authority and Member of Parliament in Yorkshire and the Humber. We've directly responded to Government consultations, seeking to give social enterprise a competitive advantage when it comes to things like the Regional Growth Fund.
